Objectives

The second AHRM Undergraduate Research and Creative Scholarship Symposium will be held this Spring in order to promote the AHRM students' active pursuing of undergraduate research projects and celebrating their excellence. Undergraduate students in Apparel, Housing, Residential Property Management, and Consumer Studies or in other majors working with AHRM faculty on original research and creative projects under the AHRM 4994 Undergraduate Research course should submit a 150 word abstract to have their work included in the symposium. Projects can be presented orally or through a poster or exhibition.

Submission guidelines:

1. Pick up the coversheet at 240 Wallace and fill it out.
2. Prepare the abstract of your project in 100-150 words. The abstract should be prepared for blind review; it should not include your name or the faculty supervisor's name. It should include the title of the project followed by a summary of the research or creative project. The summary should include the following information:
 - Background and purpose
 - Methods or procedures
 - Results or outcome
 - References, if applicable, should be included, but are not counted toward the word limit.
3. Submit a paper copy of your coversheet and abstract to Ms. Elizabeth Long in 240 Wallace Hall by **5:00pm, Friday March 31, 2012.**
